From 6 to 10 February 2012 the first official MARES annual meeting will be organized here in Ghent. During this week all current enrolled MARES doctoral researchers come together and MARES scientific and management board have their meetings.

- Specialized training in presentation skills: o a specialized training given by Frederik Imbo (a professional actor) in presentation skills will be organized during the week. The training focusses on how to do a presentation, how to interact with the public, proper design of slide shows, ...

The training consists of three moments: Monday afternoon from 2pm to 5 pm, Tuesday morning from 9 am to 12 and Thursday from 9 am to 5 pm.

- Science café: o On Monday and Wednesday evening we plan to organize a science café. Aim of this activity is to have 2-3 researchers briefly explaining what they are working on and to get into discussion about this with the MARES doctoral researchers. o The first science café takes place on Monday at the building S8 in the evening (between 7 and 9pm), the second one takes places at a pub in Ghent on Wednesday evening.

- Visit to the European Commission: o On Friday afternoon 10 February we will visit the European Commission and have the opportunity to talk with some commissioners about global change and sustainable development. We still have many places available for people who wish to join. We leave at 11 am and plan to be back by 6 pm.
