Position of the course

The hospital traineeship during the training in family practice are family practice relevant. The student follow this traineeship from the point of family doctor referring to the hospital. He learns the different technical possibilities, the hospital context and decision making in secondary care. Special attention is given to the follow up at home of patients with complex chronic diseases with emphasis on the importance of cooperation between first and secondary care and multidisciplinary approach.
