### Part 1: Work Plachement

1. Completing a mandatory internship in a company or institution active in the field of engineering (contractor, engineering, architect, land surveyor, technical service cities - municipalities province - Flemish Community - federal government). The preference is for a company where research and development is done. This in preparation of the thesis. This second stage is an introduction to the field where students gain experience as part of their training. Students come into contact and get to perform advanced and difficult tasks with which they may face in a later appeal function. The students work in the internship company as the other employees of that company. On this occasion they also have the opportunity to observe how certain things constructed and implemented.

2. The internship lasts minus 160 hours (4 weeks) and is always renewable. The internship can begin at the earliest after the end of the exams of the second semester of the third year and must be completed before the commencement of the examinations of the second semester of the fourth year. In principle, the training period by more in the summer between the third and fourth years. The engineering department can give permission for this internship to deviate.

3. The internship can continue at home and abroad

4. The procedure at the beginning of the 3rd year undergraduate engineering, the coordinator explained.

5. A listing of possible placement firms available.
6. The procedure of the internship can be found on the web site FEA.
7. Students are applying themselves for an internship.
8. The platform Plato, the internship can be followed. The student completes his internship details on Plato
9. He makes his internship contract through the web application. The risk analysis and the workplace checklist be completed by the company. Service Medical Supervision of UZ Ghent judge whether a health surveillance is needed.
10. After the end of the internship, the student writes a placement report. This is charged on Plato. Similarly, a read-only version is issued on paper.

**Part 2: Study-trip or alternative assignment.**

Study-trip: This lasts one week. The teachers determine the destination.

Alternative assignment: Students not participating in the study-trip run 40 hours (one week) additional internship.

Initial competences

The student must have the basic knowledge from the undergraduate engineering and "bachelor work placement" ended.

Final competences

- 1 Perform advanced and difficult tasks from the field, architectural concepts and building techniques analyzing and implementation.
- 2 During the study trip analyze foreign construction concepts and methods of implementation and assimilate.
- 3 To apply the acquired knowledge in an industrial and social context.
- 4 Advanced and difficult assignments ONCRETE working methodically, focusing on the preconditions for the technical realization.
- 5 Ability to work in a team.
