Position of the course

In the last year of the Bachelor Cycle, the practical skills, essential to meet the later professional requirements, are further practised. The level of French (pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary) is optimised through oral and written expertises.

Contents

In this course, the practical, oral and written skills are of central importance. Various exercises, based essentially on authentic material (texts and recorded presentations) will help to increase the student's proficiency. The emphasis falls on a communicative-strategic approach, i.e. the student acquires a richer lexicon (general and economic), enhances his grammatical knowledge and practises strategies that allow him to participate in meaningful communication. Active participation in the language class is required.

Initial competences

Knowledge acquired during French I and French II.

Final competences

Be able to read and understand economic texts,
Be able to understand specialised lectures
Be able to resume these texts and lectures
Be able to make an oral presentation in a precise and comprehensive way
At the end of the year, the students can discuss economic topics in correct and fluent French.
