This course deals with the geomorphological approach and aims to provide an insight in the interaction between the natural environment and Man in the past.

Subsequent to a general introduction a number of case-studies based on own research are elaborated. Special attention is paid to the Mediterranean (Portugal, Spain, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Jordan, Egypt, Tunisia, Morocco...) but also case studies of NW Europe are presented.
